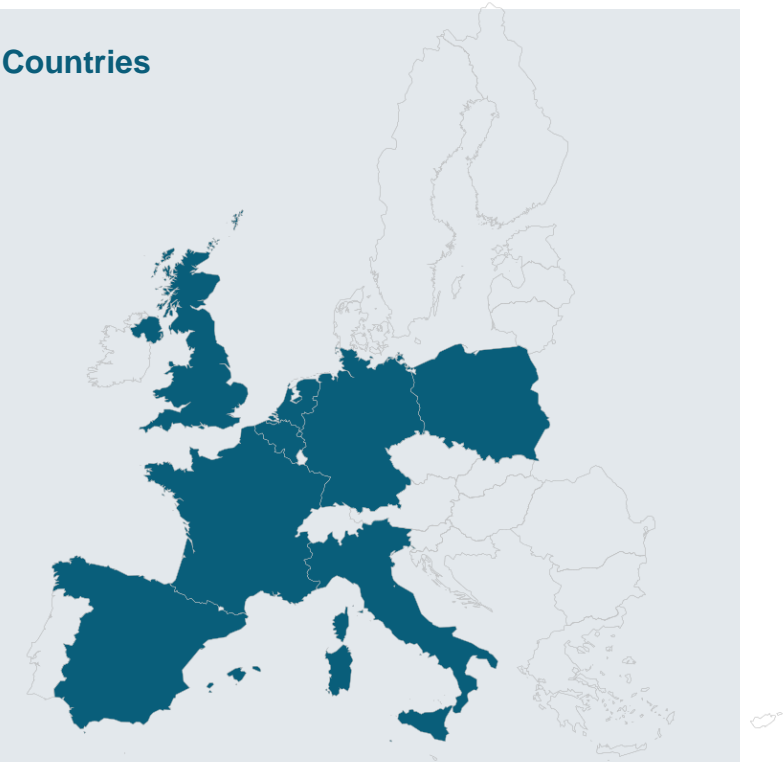
200 successful interviews per country
